### **WISCONSIN FORWARD EXAM**

The <u>Wisconsin Forward Exam</u> is designed to gauge how well students are doing in relation to the Wisconsin Academic Standards. The Forward Exam tests students in grades 3 - 8 and grade 10 in the areas of English language arts (ELA), mathematics, science and social studies. Our school is scheduled to take the Wisconsin Forward Exam on days from <u>March 20 - April 28</u>. During this time, your help is appreciated to make sure students get a good night of sleep and eat breakfast before coming to school. Also, please try to avoid appointments during the school day and early / late arrivals and departures, if possible.

<u>Middle School Parents and Elementary Parents Dropping of Kids</u> - Please pull up to the end of drop -off zone and unload passengers when in the zone only. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

Elementary Parents Walking Students to the Entrance in the AM - Beginning Tuesday, September 6th we ask that you hand your child off to the staff at the school doors each morning. Your child will be guided to his/her classroom by staff. We need to minimize hallway congestion and keep traffic moving. Staff members are readily available to help your child. The doors open at 8:35 am.

At the end of the day, please wait behind the cones for your child. We want to make sure students are exiting safely and being picked up by the correct adults. By minimizing the congestion that happens by the doors, it will improve staff visibility of all kids. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

The elementary and middle school will be using a new badge sign-in/sign-out system for all guests, volunteers, and visitors effective October 31, 2022. The badges will be a helpful and easy way to recognize "approved" visitors in the building. An exception to the badge sign-in/sign-out process will be the Early Riser Readers program the first Wednesday of each month. In addition to a badge sign-in/sign-out system, items that are brought to school that need to be given to students will need to be left in the office. The office staff will communicate to the teacher so the student can retrieve the items from the office. These items include anything related to a student's locker, art project, instrument, clothes, lunch, etc. Parents and other adults will need to remain in the office and allow the staff to make sure the student has what he/she needs. Lastly, younger elementary students who arrive late to school will need to be dropped off in the main office and will be escorted to their class by an office staff member, administrator, or counselor. Parents will not be permitted to walk their child to the classroom.

Just a reminder to parents to please let the office know about any absences when your child is not in school or needs to arrive late / leave early: home sick or for a personal reason, leaving early / coming late for an appointment, etc. We are thankful you communicate with the homeroom teachers about these absences; please include the office (<a href="mailto:dhassinger@goresorters.com">dhassinger@goresorters.com</a>) as well. Per our Elem/Middle School Student Handbook -
